CALL FOR Erasmus+ Short Term PhD Traineeship Mobility 2025-2026

We are pleased to inform PhD students that we have **at least one (01) doctoral** short **Mobility** under Erasmus+ KA171, which is pursued by the Inter-Institutional Agreement (IIA) between UNIVERSITE OF BISKRA and IZMIR INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY (Türkiye). The nominated applicant(s) will spend **5 to 30 days** at the receiving institution during the second semester 2025-2026; to be finished **before 31 July 2026**.

Short-Term PhD Mobility

This is a program designed to better address the learning and educational needs of PhD candidates and to promote equal opportunities, enabling them to participate in **short-term internship mobility** abroad. For recent PhD graduates ('post-docs')¹, short-term internship opportunities are offered after graduation, provided they applied while still a PhD candidate. Virtual mobility may also be included alongside physical mobility.

The program financially supports participants with fewer opportunities (FWO*) to participate in the call for applications.

Eligibility

- ✓ You are a PhD student in the Biskra University Department of Architecture.
- ✓ The accepted domains according to the **Department names** in IZTECH Faculty of Architecture <https://arch.iyte.edu.tr/en/home-page/> as follows:
Department of Architecture,
Department of Industrial Design,
Department of Conservation and Restoration of Cultural Heritage
Department of City and Regional Planning
- ✓ A student must have a CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) of at least 10.50 out of 20 for undergraduate students and 11 out of 20 for graduate students to apply for Erasmus+ Mobility.
- ✓ The applicant should have at least B1 in English (to be documented)
- ✓ The applicant should have an acceptance letter from one of the above-mentioned departments.

¹ "Postdocs" may participate in internship mobility programs under the same conditions as other recent graduates within 12 months of graduation.

[Please note that your mobility should take place between 25 May 2026 – 31 July 2026. Please consider the required time for receiving visa, IZTECH academic calendar, and the Eid al-Adha (26 May-30 May) while planning your mobility.]

- ✓ Submit your candidature before the deadlines.

Priority Status: First-time participants. (Previous beneficiaries of the Izmir Institute of Technology mobility are welcome to apply but will be ranked after new applicants.)

Evaluation of student applications are given below:

- **Academic achievement level** (50%, out of total 100 points)
- **English language level** (50%, out of total 100 points)
- Additional point for FWO students (with disabilities, or students who rely on state's social care/shelter support for a living or are disaster victims provided that the disability/ state's social service support/disaster support is documented) (+10 points)
- Reduction of points for students who have previously benefited with or without a grant by previous Erasmus+ (2014-2020 or 2021-2027) within the same study cycle, from study or internship mobility within the scope of the same project type. (-10 points)
- Reduction of points for students who apply for the mobility in the country of citizenship (nationality of Turkish Republic) (-10 points)
- Reduction of points for students in case of failure to participate in the mobility despite being selected, without submitting a waiver notice in due time (-10 points)
- Reduction of points for students in case of unexcused non-attendance to the meetings/trainings organized in relation to (*if applicable in the institution*), in the subsequent applications to be made by the student

Mobility Grant* consists of daily support and travel support. It may also consist of the additional financial support for the people with fewer opportunities (FWO***).

Travel support: 275 Euro (If by **green travel****, it is 320 Euro)

Daily support:

Days 5–14: 79 euros per day
Days 15–30: 56 euros per day
(including 2 travel days for 1 outbound and 1 inbound)
